Master programme in Philosophy and Economics

General information

The minimum entry requirements for the master programme in Philosophy and Economics at the University of Vienna require a bachelor degree or equivalent degree in a relevant discipline. At the time of application, at least 150 ECTS credits of courses must have been completed (i.e. there is only one semester of full-time study remaining).

Admission also requires that applicants have knowledge of philosophy or political theory, as well as of economics corresponding to 15 ECTS credits each (equivalent to half a semester of full-time study). These courses should typically be completed at the time of the application. However, if these courses are still in progress and completed before the start of the programme, please also include them here.
